 complete the page.
- This week we will be focusing on punctuation including capital letters and full stops.
- Please go through the PowerPoint with you child (Capital letter PowerPoint)
- Complete the worksheet entitled Full stops and capital letters
- Phonics- using the Sound like Phonics programme link https://slp.cjfallon.ie/ click on book C and go to unit 1 The Aquarium.
- Go down to double consonants and click on -II -ff. The children will be focusing on these final sounds this week
- Complete all 8 interactive activities
- Roll and read activities there are 2 worksheets attached on for each sound -ll and -ff. Roll a dice and say a word on that line if you can say it correctly you can colour it in. Try to fill in one whole horizontal line by correctly saying all 5 words. This activity can be done with one person or more.
- Pick 10 words from each of the roll and read worksheets (20 words in total) and put them into sentences in your homework copy.

Maths

This week we will be continuing with our work on time. It may be beneficial to revise last weeks work of o' clock and half past. Continue to engage you child in time related activities throughout that week, including asking them the time throughout the day, having them count how long an activity took etc.

Figure it Out- Pg 49 *If possible, could you take a photo of this complete page and upload it to Seesaw.

Time is a lot about revision and practice including seeing and reading clocks as well as writing times in word format.

I have attached a worksheet entitled Analogue clock template activity. This worksheet will be especially useful for revising time. The worksheet contains 12 blank clock faces. You can choose any 12 times (o'clock or half past) and have your child draw the hand in the correct place to represent the time and write the time below in word format. *If you place this sheet in a poly pocket you can write the times in whiteboard marker, they can then be erased and the worksheet can be reused multiple times.

The are 2 interactive time matching games on twinkl, one for o' clock and one for half past. If possible log into twinkl and complete these activities.

 pictures below the questions mark. Once they pick one picture lick on it to see if they
 are correct. Have them answer the questions also with Is é.
- Complete Pg 65 in Bua na Cainte (attached) An Nuacht, go though the vocabulary on the left and right of the page.
- At the end of each theme there is a corresponding scéal (story)
- Return to the Sa Bhaile theme

- At the bottom of the page you will see scéal, click on this and it will open the scéal
 Na Trí Mhuc
- Listen to the story with your child
- Complete Pg 66 in Bua na Cainte, go through the vocabulary with your child and revise the colours before completing the page.
- Also at the end of each theme the children usually get to play some games of Biongó (bingo)
- Click on the Sa Bhaile theme at the bottom of the page next to scéal you will see Biongó, click into this.
- The child can pick 6 words (you will find all the words they can choose from by clicking the graduation cap in the bottom right of the screen)
- When your child has chosen 6 words hit the play button and they can cross off any words that are called out
- If not all the words have been called out, you can have another game until they have been classed out. This game is even more fun with others ©

Read through Pg 78 and 79 in Small World and complete the activities.



Science- This week the children will be investigating sound. Ask your child to share and previous knowledge that they make have about sounds and how they are created. 
Additional activities

These are some suggested activities/resources if your child would like some additional activities to complete.

- Children could complete a nature hunt around the garden and draw and label any living things that they find. They can then categorise these into different groups i.e. insects, plants, trees, found on the ground etc.
- Art activities- they YouTube channel Art Hub for Kids has some great drawing tutorials, the children have used this before and are familiar with it.
- Comic strip- you child can create a comic strip of something exciting that happened during the week (templates available on twinkl). Encourage your child to write speech bubbles and full sentences to accompany their comic strip.
- Additional maths activities-children can also complete any worksheets/ activities
 from Twinkl which are revision of topics already covered including addition,
 subtraction, money, 2D/3D shapes, data, fractions and place value
- Children can go back through the previously completed weeks in their Spellbound and revise their spellings. You could also choose any of these words and ask your child to put them into sentences. Look out for any words that your child is spelling incorrectly and revise these words in particular.
- Storyline Online is a great free resource that the children are already familiar with, there is a verity of different stories which they children can listen to and each story is accompanied by activities and worksheets
- RTE will be broadcasting school on TV from 11-12 Monday to Friday on RTÉ 2. Your child may wish to watch and participate in these lessons.


