History – This week the children will be looking at space travel. To introduce this topic go though the PowerPoint Space Travel with your child and discuss. Complete Pg 90 and 91 in Small World. Science- This week the children will be learning about the solar system. To introduce this topic to your child go though the PowerPoint What is up in Space with your child and discuss. Compete Pg 86 in Small world- Upload to Seesaw.

<u>Art</u>

This week we will be linking our art with our SESE and create space-based art. The children will be creating crayon resist space art.

What you will need

- Crayons
- White card
- Paintbrush
- Black water colour or watered down craft paint
- Paper towels

Method

• Start by coloring a space scene on the cardstock. Stars, planets, shooting stars, rockets, aliens, etc. Color them in completely with the crayons.



• Brush over the whole paper with the black water colour. The waxy crayon won't absorb the paint and it beads up a little



• Pat with a paper towel to clean off paint that beads up on the crayon



• Let dry, and display your beautiful space picture




