'That man was so nice this morning,' they say. 'And now he is so cross and so rude. How very odd!' ■

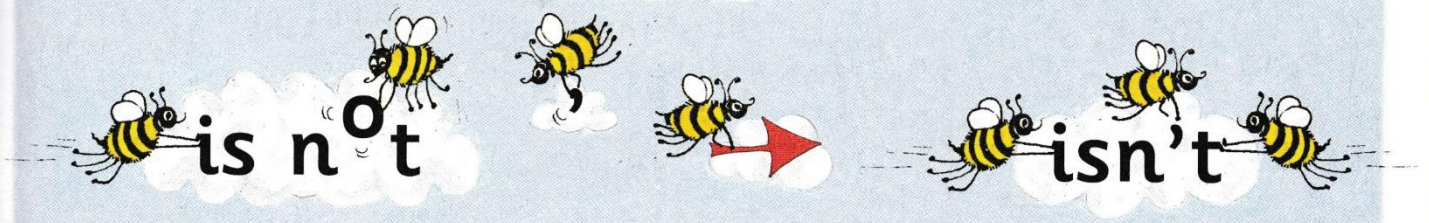

Contractions

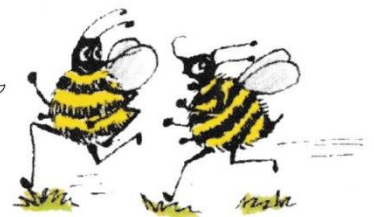
