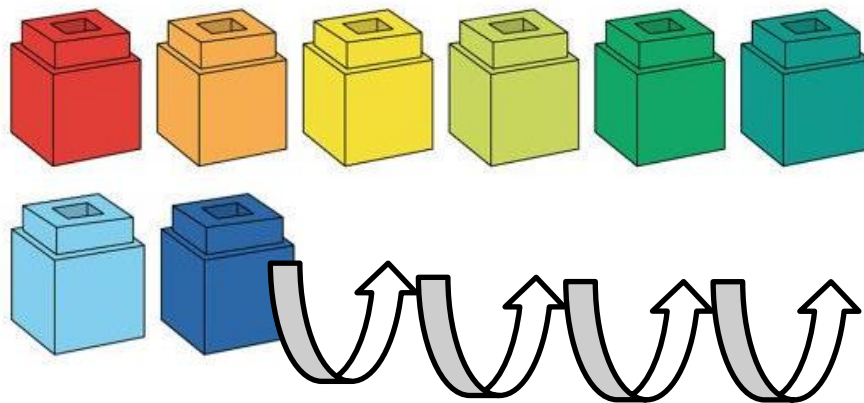

Finding the difference (More than/Less than)

Using cubes/blocks/lego/pasta pieces work on finding the difference between sets.

Lay out the above items like in the example below. Ask your child to count the number of items in the top row and the number of items in the bottom row. Ask them to find the difference between the two rows by counting.

Start at 2 and count up to 6. The number of jumps is 4 so the difference between 2 and 6 is 4



Question your child on which set has more/which set has less

3D Shapes

- Remind your child that 3D shapes are solid shapes. They are not flat.
- Talk about the basic properties of a cube, cuboid, sphere and cylinder. If you have examples around your house to show them that would be a great help.
 - Cube - 6 square faces, 8 corners, straight edges (all same length)
 - Cuboid - 6 rectangular faces, 8 corners, straight edges (not all the same length)
 - Sphere - 1 curved face, no corners, no edges (perfectly round shape)
 - Cylinder - 2 circular faces, 1 curved face, no corners, 2 curved edges

Time

- Revise o'clock. Remind your child that the long hand (minute hand) always points to 12 and the small hand (hour hand) points to the hour

Addition

- Complete the sums. I have included 2 word problems at the end. Have your child read them carefully. Remind them that the word 'altogether' means add as does the word 'total'. Make sure they write the sum and not just the answer.
- Complete attached worksheet based on all of the above

SESE

Mini Beasts

- Remind your child what a mini beast is. Definition below:

Mini beasts are small creatures without backbones

- Remind them that they learned recently about the butterfly and see if they can recall the different stages of the butterfly life cycle: egg, caterpillar, chrysalis, butterfly
- Tell them that the butterfly is only one type of mini beast and that there are lots more
- Use the attached PDF file of photographs to introduce some more mini beasts
- Discuss the pictures and identify the mini beasts that have legs/have no legs
- Carry out a mini beast trail in your garden and complete the attached worksheet

Mini beast Art (Optional)

Look at the pictures below. Select a mini beast and try and make him. Use your imagination. The pictures are just to give you some ideas.

 - Picture 3: Mary and Joseph travel to Bethlehem where Jesus is born in a stable
 - Picture 4: Jesus teaches us about God
 - Picture 5: Jesus shares one last meal with his friends (The Passover)
 - Picture 6: Jesus talks and listens to the children and blesses them
 - Picture 7: Jesus carries his cross to the top of the hill. He dies on the cross
 - Picture 8: Jesus rises from the dead three days after he dies on the cross
- Watch the Vox Pox video and ask your child on completion what they have learned about God this year
